

MILESTONE

- In our first project **Quchu Santas** we dropped gifts to over 120 LGBTQIA persons around the country in shelters and those who were struggling and gave homeless shelter LGBTQIA persons in Uganda a smile in the Christmas season by giving them good tidings of gifts as well as personal essentials from all over the world. The aim was to combat the isolation that comes with not having a home to go back to or extreme loneliness when the world is celebrating, and to remind recipients they are a part of a huge community that is a FAMILY that love and accepts us as we are.
- The Participants from the first and Second Cohort of the Twekobe Project concluded with final sessions of Branding & Marketing where they were trained on essential elements of uplifting their own personal businesses through creative skills of branding and Marketing.
- 2023 Carried out online mental dialogues where all LGBTQ+ persons got to interact with a clinical psychiatrist getting a clearer understanding on what MENTAL HEALTH is including self check and help tips.

Our Co-founder won the 2023 Winq Hivos International Activist Award of Free to be me .

We also reopened our economic empowerment center.




